


To Whom It May Concern:

ORA has been working with Robyn Kestler, an *agunah*, since June of 2012. Robyn and Jute David Kestler have been married since 1993 and have four children together. They separated in December of 2010 due to Mr. Kestler's infidelity and abusive behavior. Although Mr. Kestler is no longer religious, he refuses to give his wife a *get*.

After spending several years litigating their divorce, Robyn turned to the Beth Din of America to help her receive her *get*. When Mr. Kestler refused to comply with the *beis din* process, the Beth Din of America issued a *seruv* against him on March 22, 2012.

Given the history of the case and the issuance of the *seruv*, it is appropriate for community members to do everything in their power within *halacha* and civil law to convince Mr. Kestler to give his wife a *get*, including public rallies. Furthermore, since Mr. Kestler's parents (Ken and Georgette Kestler) have been supporting their son and encouraging him in his recalcitrance, it is appropriate to protest against them as well.
