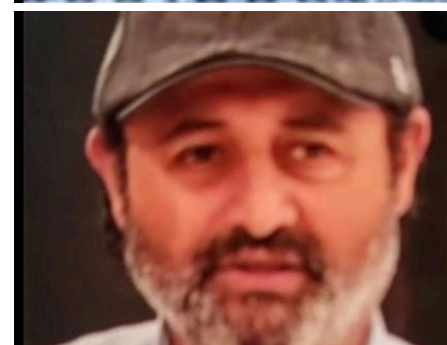
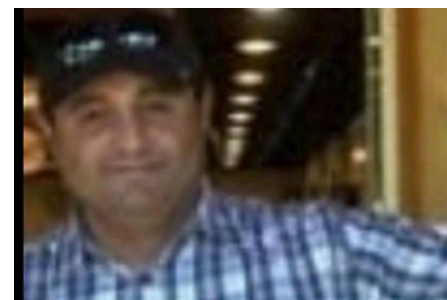


MORDEHAY MOSHE

GET-REFUSER

- Mordehay and Vered married in 2015 and separated in 2021.
- Mordehay has been refusing to give Vered a *get*, a Jewish bill of divorce.
- Without a *get*, Vered is unable to remarry and is left an *agunah*, chained to a dead marriage.
- **The Vaad Harabonim of Queens issued a *psak* against Mordehay**, stating that he is a *sarvan ladin* (recalcitrant to submit to Beis Din) for refusing to come for adjudication of the *get*.
- **Jewish Law forbids (שו"ע יו"ד של"ד ואה"ע קנ"ד)** among other things: engaging him in conversation, counting him towards a minyan, and providing him with food or drink.
- Mordehay lives in Brooklyn, NY.

The Beth Din of Queens has summoned **Mordehay Moshe**, residing at [REDACTED] to the Beth Din for a *Din Torah* with the Claimant, **Vered Ben-Shushan**, for all claims arising out of and related to their marriage and its dissolution.

The Beth Din issued the first summons on March 25, 2024 the second summons on April 1, 2024, and the third and final summons on April 8, 2024. However, **Mordehay Moshe** has not responded affirmatively to the Beth Din and has refused submit to a Din Torah proceeding with the Claimant in any Beth Din.

We therefore notify the public that the *Shulchan Aruch* (Code of Jewish Law) considers

Mordehay Moshe a Mesarev L'Din

מרדכי משה מסרבת לדין

in contempt of the Beth Din

Therefore, halacha dictates that **Mordehay Moshe** is required to conduct himself as one under a ban of excommunication, as described in YD 334.

The Claimant may take any steps legally available to her to obtain relief. It is a great *Mitzvah* to encourage **Mordehay Moshe** to appear in front of the Beth Din for a Din Torah with the Claimant.
