CHAIM TOISIG GET-REFUSER

FACTS:

- Chaim and Raizel married in 1999 and separated in 2013. They have five children together.
- Chaim has been refusing to give Raizel a get, a
 Jewish bill of divorce, for almost a decade.
- Without a get, Raizel is unable to remarry and is left an agunah, chained to a dead marriage.
- The Rabbanut Beit Din (Rabbinical court) of Jerusalem, Israel, issued a psak (ruling) of kfiyat get, compelling Chaim to give a get.
- Chaim lives in Bloomingburg, New York.
- Jewish Law forbids (שו"ע יו"ד של"ד ואה"ע קנ"ד): conducting business with Chaim, engaging him in conversation, counting him towards a minyan, providing him with food or drink.
