## **Fellowship Description:**

The Organization for the Resolution of Agunot (ORA) invites current undergraduate students to apply to the 9<sup>th</sup> cohort of its college fellowship program for the 2023-2024 academic year. ORA Campus Fellows will become leaders in preventing situations of *get*-abuse and raising awareness about the *halakhic* prenuptial agreement on their college campuses. Fellows will learn from experts in the prevention of *get*-abuse and receive training in leadership skills and advocacy.

#### Who You Are:

Qualifications of an ideal candidate:

- Self-motivated, organized, and passionate about ORA's advocacy work
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Involved in Jewish life on campus
- Sensitive to Orthodox communal standards and the sanctity of the halakhic process

## What to expect:

As a fellow, you will:

- ❖ Participate in **7 Leadership Training Seminars**, which will take place on Sunday mornings throughout the academic year (approximately 1 per month).
- ❖ Learn from experts in the field about *get*-refusal, domestic violence, and the halachic prenup through both **halachic sources and lived experiences**.
- ❖ Plan a **campus program** or project to raise awareness about *get*-abuse and *halakhic* prenuptial agreements.
- ❖ Learn to **guide engaged couples** in signing *halakhic* prenuptial agreements.
- ❖ Become certified as a **notary public** in order to independently facilitate the signing of *halakhic* prenuptial agreements.

\*Please note this fellowship will be a hybrid of virtual and in-person seminars, located in the tri-state area. Additionally, there will be an in-person Shabbaton in NJ.
